## SPECIAL FEATURES

From the mountain slopes of Wellington in South Africa, the grapes are grown on weathered granite and sandstone with a high clay content providing plenty of water retention. Only the best grapes are chosen for vinification and de-stemmed before gentle pressing and malolactic fermentation. 80% of the wine is aged in 3 year old French oak for 12 months and 20% in stainless steel. The wood is barely noticeable in the end result which has a surprising fruity freshness.

Intense ruby red, good varietal character with a beautifully delicate, smooth palate with plenty of berry, and wild red fruit aromas and lingering finish. Well-integrated oak, plenty of vanilla and spice on the nose. Full-bodied but not sugary or concentrated. Extremely harmonious.
