SPECIAL FEATURES

Classic South African red wine from the Truter family vineyards. Pinotage started life as a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault and does exceptionally well on the mountain slopes where it enjoys granite and sandstone soils with a high clay content - good for both acidity and water retention. The grapes are in full sunshine during the summer with cool nights, again adding to the typicity and aromas of the varietal. Grapes are de-stemmed and fermented over 8 days before being pressed and matured in a mix of French and American oak.

TASTING NOTES

Deep crimson red with a purple rim. A juicy, raspberry, intensely fruity nose, which follows through on the palate and leads to spicy notes and a lovely smooth finish.
